



## National Housing Authority Announcement

### **Subject: Declaration of intent on public administration integrity and transparency operation, and Anti-corruption policy**

In accordance with the principle of Good Corporate Governance No.1 (B.E.2559-2564) determined by the State Enterprise Policy Office, National Anti-Corruption Strategy Phase 3 (B.E.2560-2564) approved from the cabinet on 12 July 2016.

National Housing Authority as state enterprise under Ministry of Social Development and Human Security follows its Master Plan for Promotion of Good Corporate Governance and Corporate Social Responsibility (B.E.2560-2564), aiming to promote transparency, integrity, accountability in work operations of the NHA. It also help to develop a standard operation according to the principle of Good Corporate Governance of NHA.

National Housing Authority hereby issued the declaration of intent on public administration integrity and transparency policy, in order to operate with fairness, transparency, accountability and free from corruption. To accomplish this declaration of intent, the NHA shall uphold and proceed per the following guidelines:

1. Operate on the basis of NHA good corporate governance, adhere to rules, regulations, announcement and declaration on prevent and resist corruption. All the personnel shall adhere to the principle of morality ethics and disciplinary of working.
2. All personnel shall perform work with pure intensions without pursuit of benefits or abuse of power which cause damage to organization and others
3. Foster social values of the personnel of anti- corruption, support good corporative culture, have a volunteer mind and operate in accordance with corporate values. Strengthen unity to become and trustable organization.
4. Designate clear operation procedures in order to reduce conflict of interest in accordance with the good governance principle. Monitor the operation along with the policy and review guideline and criteria of working to ensure a proper operation.

5. Any action harm or risk in procurement shall not be involved, and concern any procurement to prevent beneficiaries or losers. Spend the budget effectively and efficiently by taking the enterprise's benefits into consideration.

6. NHA shall adhere to the rules, legislation and law of information security, and secrecy, communication and using information technology of enterprise.


7. Designate strategy and planning in human resource management to be accountable, enhance potentiality and strengthen skill and knowledge of working continuously.

The enterprise executives shall be leaders and initiate as a role model. This would build a confidence in the implementation of this announcement. The leader shall be committed to the management of ethical conduct and good corporate governance compliance with laws and regulation of justice. In case of officers and employees of National Housing Authority violate or fail to comply with this anti-corruption policy, executives shall provide confirmation to both inside and outside enterprise that they will not ignore to solve the problem. Any corruption found will be investigated the cause of disobedience and shall prevent such actions in the future.
